

Over 10K pass PNP entrance exams

MANILA—A total of 10,602 out of 46,419 examinees passed the latest Philippine National Police (PNP) Entrance and Promotional Examinations, the National Police Commission (Napolcom) said on Friday.

This translates to a 22.84-percent passing rate of the exams last April 28 at designated testing centers in all regions of the country.

The total number of passers is distributed as follows: 5,121 passers of the PNP Entrance (PNPE) examination, representing 15.53 percent of the 32,972 PNPE examinees; and the combined 5,481 passers of the Police Officer (3,363), Senior Police Officer (1,735), Inspector (347) and Superintendent (36) examination categories, constituting 40.76 percent of the 13,447 in-service police officers who took the PNP promotional examinations.

The eligibility conferred upon passing the PNPE is one of the requirements for appointment in the PNP as a Patrolman/Patrolwoman while passing a promotional examination is considered

appropriate for promotion to a higher rank.

“The release of the results of police exams is in consonance with the Commission’s commitment to the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) to make available the examination results within 45

working days from the date of the examinations, and in sync with the recruitment process being undertaken by the PNP,” Napolcom vice chairman, lawyer Rogelio Casurao said in a statement.

Casurao said the Napolcom is ready to detect

and address examination anomalies using answer pattern analysis.

He also reiterated the Napolcom’s earlier warning to all examinees to refrain from cheating, impersonation, perjury or violation of examination rules, among others or face sanctions with perpetual disqualification from taking future Napolcom examinations.

Number of cops facing administrative raps up 36%

MANILA -- The number of policemen charged with administrative complaints went up in the first five months of this year, the Philippine National Police (PNP) said Thursday.

Data from the PNP Internal Affairs Service (IAS) showed the number of complaints against police officers from January to May increased by 36 percent to 2,291, compared to 1,683 in the same period last year.

Meanwhile, the average number of cases on a monthly basis also increased to 458, from 337 last year.

Lawyer Alfegar Triambulo, IAS Inspector General, said most of the cops are with the rank of patrolman and are either involved in illegal drug activities, violations in police operational procedure, indiscriminate firing of their firearms, and vote-buying in the recent elections.

Faithful asked to bring plants, seeds to ex-Baguio bishop's wake

MANILA — The Diocese of Baguio has asked the faithful who want to offer flowers at the wake of retired Bishop Carlito “Otto” Cenzone to instead bring plants and seedlings.

In Circular 16-2019 issued on Thursday, Bishop Victor Bendico urged the people of the diocese to bring ornamental plants and seedlings of highland trees in line with the advocacy of his late predecessor.

“I am recommending that for those who wish to bring bouquet of flowers at the wake of Bishop Otto at the Our Lady of the Atonement Cathedral on July 3, 2019 onwards to bring ornamental plants and seedlings of highland trees instead,” he said.

“This is our response to his active role in the care for

the environment. Rest assured that these plants will be cared of in his memory,” the Baguio prelate added.

Bendico noted that his predecessor was actively involved with all aspects of life in Baguio City and the Province of Benguet and an advocate of care of the environment.

“He initiated the Tree of Life Program in the diocese to propagate bamboos for the protection of the environment,” he said.

“He headed the Fencing Committee in the city to raise funds in reinstating the children's park and fencing the entire Burnham Park for its protection and preservation,” Bendico added.

Bendico succeeded Cenzone on January 10, 2017.

The late bishop's re-

mains will be at the Baguio City Cathedral on the evening of July 2 and will remain there until July 6.

The necrological service will be at 4 p.m. on July 5 and the funeral mass will be at 8:30 a.m. on the following day at the cathedral.

Cenzone will be buried at the Congregation of the Immaculate Heart of Mary (CICM) Cemetery inside Maryhurst Seminary compound in Baguio City.

He passed away on Wednesday at the age of 80.

The former Baguio prelate served as bishop for nearly 27 years and was first appointed in 1992 as Vicar Apostolic of Tabuk, Kalinga. Cenzone was ordained priest in 1965 for the CICM. (PNA)
