

CIDG raps on 'Bikoy' revelations up for resolution

MANILA -- The cases filed by the Philippine National Police-Criminal Investigation and Detection Group (PNP-CIDG) arising from the revelations of Peter Joemel Advincula, the man behind the so-called "Ang Totoong Narcolist" video" against 36 opposition figures, is now submitted for resolution by the prosecution panel of the Department of Justice (DOJ) following the submission of counter-affidavits by the respondents.

At least two respondents, former Magdalo party-list Rep. Gary Alejano and Jonell Sangalang opted not to file a counter-affidavit.

Under the rules, the prosecution has 60 days to decide whether to dismiss the case outright or bring it to court.

The last among the respondents to file their counter-affidavits on Thursday were detained senator Leila de Lima, Jose Manuel Diokno and Danilo Songco.

Last week, Assistant Solicitor General Angelita Villanueva-Miranda urged the DOJ panel to reconsider and order the issuance of subpoena for

Jude Sabio, a lawyer of former senator Antonio Trillanes; Davao businesswoman Guillermina Barrido; and consumer advocate Perfecto Jaime Tagalog.

This after the CIDG filed new evidence in the sedition, inciting to sedition, cyber libel, libel, estafa, harboring a criminal/obstruction of justice cases.

Barrido and Tagalog have filed their sworn statements before the PNP.

The testimony of the three would have been corroborative to the initial complaint filed by the PNP-CIDG.

Also named in the complaint are Vice President Leonor Robredo, former senator Antonio Trillanes IV, Eduardo Acierto, Senators Ana Theresia N. Hontiveros-Baraquel, former Integrated Bar of the Philippines (IBP) president Abdel Fajardo, IBP president Domingo Egon Cayosa, former Supreme Court spokesperson Theodore Te, lawyers Minerva Ambrosio, Serafin Salvador, and Philip Sawali.

Senatorial candidates in the recent polls Samira Gutoc-Tomawis, Paolo Be-

nigno A. Aquino, lawyer Lorenzo "Erin" R. Tañada III, Florin Hilbay, and Romulo Macalintal were also charged.

Also charged were Yolando Villanueva Ong, Fr. Flaviano Villanueva, Fr. Albert E. Alejo, Fr. Robert Reyes, Bro. Armin A. Luistro, Cubao Diocese Bishop Honesto F. Ongtioco, retired Novaliches Bishop Teodoro Bacani Jr., Caloocan Bishop Pablo Virgilio S. David, former Catholic Bishops' Conference of the Philippines (CBCP) president Archbishop Socrates Villegas, publicist Boom Enriquez, Vicente R. Romano III, and film actor/activist Joel Saracho.

A certain alias "Sentrix" and "John Doe", along with "Bikoy", were also named for their part in the so-called Project Sodoma, which was allegedly hatched to discredit administration candidates in the May 13 elections.

The special panel of prosecutors consists of Senior Assistant State Prosecutor Olivia L. Torrevillas and Assistant State Prosecutors Gino Paolo S. Santiago and Michael John M. Humarang. (PNA)

SPECIAL TRUST FUND FOR ORPHANED, NEGLECTED KIDS SOUGHT

MANILA -- A measure seeking to provide a special trust fund amounting to PHP2,500 for each orphaned, abandoned, neglected or voluntarily-committed children has been filed at the Senate.

According to a statement on Thursday, Senator Bong Revilla filed Senate Bill 1021, which seeks a national program to support and care for these children by creating a special trust fund.

Revilla noted that the proposed law aims to aid 1.8 million orphan and abandoned children in the country, between ages 5 and 14, who might already be engaged in child labor and struggle to survive on roughly PHP65 a day or less.

"It cannot be denied that there is still a considerable

number of orphaned, abandoned, neglected or voluntarily-committed children in the country," Revilla said in his explanatory note.

"These children need the same care and protection, maybe even more, from their environment especially because of their status," he added.

The bill covers all abandoned, neglected or voluntarily-committed children, under the case of the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) or DSWD-accredited child-caring institutions.

A trust fund account in any commercial bank or in a number of commercial banks shall be opened in the name of potential beneficiaries under a memorandum of agreement to be entered into by a commercial bank and the DSWD.

The DSWD, sourcing it from a regular annual appropriation item in its budget, shall deposit the sum of PHP2,500 quarterly in every trust fund account until the account matures, unless terminated earlier by the DSWD due to the death or ineligibility of the recipient.

To maintain the real purchasing value of the said amount through the years, it shall be increased by the DSWD every three years in proportion to the average inflation rate for the said period as certified by the National Economic Development Authority.

The DSWD shall also be mandated to come up with a comprehensive monitoring system to address the needs of these children. (PNA)
